These professionals assist nurses, hospital staff and physicians in the basic care of patients. They perform duties related to patient care and comfort. The deliver basic health care to patients in order to support their optimal quality of life. Nursing assistants carry out a variety of essential tasks and are an important part of a health care team.

#### Program objectives

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#### **Admission Criteria**

To be eligible for admission to this program leading to a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS/DEP), candidates must meet one of the following requirements:

- · Hold a Secondary School Diploma or its recognized equivalent, for example, an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary V studies, or a postsecondary diploma such as a Diploma of College Studies (SEC) or a Bachelor's degre
- Be at least 16 years of age on September 30 of the school year in which their training is to begin and have earned the Secondary IV credits in language of instruction, second language and mathematics in the programs of study established by the Minister, or have been granted recognition for equivalent learning
- · Be at least 18 years of age upon entry into the program and have the following functional prerequisites: the successful completion of the General Development Test or recognition of equivalent learning

### DVS

This program of professional studies prepares students for the practice of the profession of personal care attendant and live-in caregiver in the health and social services field.

#### Program objectives

The purpose of this profession is to provide assistance and care to clients of all ages with physical, psychological or psychosocial illnesses or disabilities in the public, private and community networks. The purpose of the profession is to compensate for the person's incapacities and to assist them in maintaining or restoring their autonomy and state of health.

#### **Program Content – Competencies**

- · Situate oneself with regard to the profession and the training process 30h
- · Establish a supportive relationship 60h
- · Adopt relational approaches with clients presenting cognitive or mental problems and neurodevelopmental disorders 60h

- · Provide assistance with activities of daily living 120h
